SCHENGEN VISA FOR FAMILY MEMBERS OF EU CITIZENS

For the purposes of Legislative Decree 30/2007, the term “family member” refers to:

- a) the spouse (the marriage must be duly registered in Italy);
- b) the partner with whom the Union citizen has contracted a registered partnership, in accordance with the legislation of a Member State;
- c) direct descendants under the age of 21 or dependants, including those of the spouse or partner;
- d) dependent direct ascendants of the spouse or partner.

Required documentation

1. Visa application form duly completed in all its parts and printed from the following link: <https://e-applicationvisa.esteri.it>

NB: It is important that the barcode on the last page is clearly printed.

2. Original passport (or other travel document recognized by the Italian Government) and a copy thereof, valid for at least three months beyond the expiry date of the requested visa, containing at least two blank pages and issued no more than 10 years ago.
3. One [ICAO](#)-compliant passport photograph.
4. [Statement of guarantee and accommodation, filled in by the inviting person and a copy of his/her passport;](#)
5. For spouses: a copy of the extract of the marriage certificate (issued by the Italian Municipality or by the competent authority of another Schengen country).
6. For children of EU citizens: an extract of the birth certificate issued by the Italian Municipality or by the competent authority of another Schengen country. The physical presence of the persons exercising parental responsibility is also required, together with a valid identity document. If one of the parents is deceased, a death certificate legalized by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs must be submitted.
7. Copy of the biological children's passport (pages 1, 2, 3, and 4).
8. For ascendants (parents, grandparents): proof that they are financially dependent on the EU citizen.
9. Any other document considered relevant to the visa application.
