SCHENGEN VISA FOR TOURISM

1. Visa application form duly completed in all its parts and printed from the following link: <https://e-applicationvisa.esteri.it>

NB: It is important that the barcode on the last page is clearly printed.

2. Original passport (or other travel document recognized by the Italian Government) and a copy thereof, valid for at least three months beyond the expiry date of the requested visa, containing at least two blank pages and issued no more than 10 years ago.
3. For non-Tanzanian nationals: original and copy of the valid work permit and residence permit.
4. One [ICAO](#)-compliant passport photograph.
5. Schengen travel medical insurance (covering emergency medical treatment, hospitalization and repatriation, with a minimum coverage of EUR 30,000), valid for all Schengen States and for the entire duration of the intended stay.
6. Round-trip flight reservation (purchase of the ticket is not mandatory).
7. Copies of any previously issued visas.
8. Consular fee, payable exclusively in Tanzanian Shillings and in cash on the day of the appointment. To verify the current amount, please consult the section "[cost for a visa and how to pay](#)" on this website.
9. Bank statements for the last three months, together with a bank introduction letter (original, signed and stamped).
10. Documents relating to the applicant's employment or economic status:
 - Company owners/directors: TIN Number, business licence, TRA documents, BRELA extract, company registration documents and company bank statements for the last three months accompanied by a bank introduction letter (originals or certified copies).
 - Employees: original employer's letter, valid employment contract, salary slips for the last three months, and personal bank statements for the last three months accompanied by a bank introduction letter (all originals, signed and stamped).
 - Unemployed applicants: proof of pension, insurance benefits, rental income or other sources of income must be provided.



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- Applicants who are not financially independent: Financial Responsibility Declaration signed by the sponsor (for students, minors, elderly parents, unemployed applicants, etc.); copy of the sponsor's identity document; proof of sufficient financial means as described above.

11. Proof of accommodation:

a. Independent travellers must provide a complete travel itinerary and hotel reservation.

b. Applicants invited by a private individual residing in Italy must provide:

- An invitation letter in which the host guarantees adequate accommodation, undertakes to cover the costs of the stay, confirms that the guest will not engage in employment in Italy, and guarantees that the guest will leave Italian territory before the expiry of the visa issued;
- [A declaration of guarantee and hospitality](#) duly completed and signed by the host;
- A copy of the host's passport or identity document.

12. For minors:

a. If the minor is travelling with only one parent, the presence of the other parent is also required in order to provide official consent before the Consular Officer. A copy of the parent's passport or identity document and the original birth certificate legalized by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs must be submitted.

b. If the minor is travelling with both parents, copies of the parents' passports or identity documents and the original birth certificate legalized by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs must be submitted together with the other required documents.

c. If the minor is travelling with a legal guardian, the original guardianship order issued by the Juvenile Court and legalized by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs must be submitted, together with a copy of the guardian's passport or identity document and the original birth certificate legalized by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

13. Any other document relevant to the visa application.



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
