Schengen Visa for Family Reunification with Third-Country Nationals

1. Visa application form duly completed in all its parts and printed from the following link: <https://e-applicationvisa.esteri.it>

NB: It is important that the barcode on the last page is clearly printed.

2. Original passport (or other travel document recognized by the Italian Government) and a copy thereof, valid for at least three months beyond the expiry date of the requested visa, containing at least two blank pages and issued no more than 10 years ago.
3. One [ICAO](#)-compliant passport photograph.
4. Consular fee, payable exclusively in Tanzanian Shillings and in cash on the day of the appointment. To verify the current amount, please consult the section "[cost for a visa and how to pay](#)" on this website.
5. Nulla Osta issued for no more than 6 months by the competent Sportello Unico
6. For spouses: marriage certificate translated into English and legalized by the Tanzanian Ministry of Foreign Affairs.
7. Copies of the biological children's passports (pages 1, 2, 3, and 4).
8. For children: local birth certificate translated into English and legalized by the Tanzanian Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

The physical presence of the persons exercising parental responsibility is required, together with a valid identity document. In the event of the death of one of the parents, a death certificate legalized by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs must be submitted.

9. Any other document relevant to the visa application.
